



LLOYD W. PELLMAN
1998 - 2004

Lloyd "Bill" W. Pellman was sworn in by the Board of Supervisors as the ninth County Counsel on August 5, 1998.

Mr. Pellman graduated from Ohio State University in 1965 with a degree in Education and obtained his law degree from Loyola Law School.¹

He worked as a teacher, then at the Jet Propulsion Laboratory before starting his career with the Office of County Counsel as a Deputy County Counsel in 1973. He became an Assistant County Counsel in 1984 and a Senior Assistant two years later, which position he held until his appointment to County Counsel in 1998.² After 31 years of County service, Mr. Pellman retired in 2004 and then joined the law firm of Brown, Winfield & Canzoneri, and then Nossaman LLP in 2005.³

During his tenure, Mr. Pellman created and filled the position of "Litigation Cost Manager" to address increasing litigation costs.
